# FINANCE CORNER

\$212,557.19	\$211,750.00

Giving for the year is on track – thank you for a good November. We are still showing a negative budget as we have had a number of unexpected expenses that were not reflected in the budget. This has us operating at a significant loss for the year. Budgeted giving for next year will increase noticeably.

Thank you to those that have given a year-end contribution. We hope you will continue your generosity through 2026. We appreciate our congregation and the many ways you give – through time, prayers and funds.

## December Key Finance Meeting Takeaways

- General Account balance was up slightly.
- A draft of Memorial Policy was reviewed and discussed. Several updates were suggested and an updated version will be shared in January for adoption.
- The 2026 budget was discussed in depth. Expenses were reviewed line by line with a few things reduced or pushed back a year. Income was evaluated and expectations were increased. This reduced our deficit to about \$20,000 - assuming Pastor share for the entire year and no contingency funds. Other cost saving items are being investigated, such as refinancing the loan.
